ITINERARY

Day 1 September 21, Friday: Depart for Dublin

This evening depart Atlanta Hartsfield-Jackson International Airport for your overseas journey to Dublin on Delta Airlines. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served aloft. (D)

Day 2 September 22, Saturday: Arrive Dublin – Corrib River Cruise - Galway

Arrive at Dublin Airport, proceed through passport control, claim your luggage, and a Peter's Way Tours tour manager/guide will meet you upon your exit from Customs. Then, board the motor coach and soon you will be on your way to Galway, the capital of the west and affectionately known as "The City of the Tribes."

On arrival to Galway, enjoy a **cruise on Lough Corrib including tea and scones**. This journey on the Corrib Princess takes passengers along the Majestic River Corrib and onto the lake, providing visitors with wonderful views of the historic monuments and scenery, which makes this one of the most spectacular waterways in Ireland. The visitors will see unsurpassed views of the historic monuments and natural amenities that make this one of the most spectacular waterway in Ireland. The cruise lasts 90 minutes, approximately, and is taken aboard The Corrib Princess, a purposed built leisure cruiser with a capacity for 157 passengers. The Princess sails from Woodquay in the heart of Galway City. Continue for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Galway. (B,D)

Day 3 September 23, Sunday: Connemara, Kylemore – Evening/Formal Concert

Irish breakfast at your hotel. This morning, travel through the Connemara region en route to Kylemore Abbey. This is the country of the "Quiet Man" and "The Purple Taxi" – two famous films made in this region. It is an area full of contrast - granite mountains populated only by sheep with hundreds of lakes forming a fisherman's paradise and its seacoast with many sandy beaches. Its stonewalls, small farms, thatched cottages (in isolated splendor with its heather covered hills), creates an unforgettable scene for all its visitors. A tour takes us from Galway to the lake dotted center of Connemara at Maam Cross.

Independent lunch.

Visit **Kylemore Abbey**, a gothic-style castle, built in the 19th century by Mr. Heny, a rich Liverpool merchant, that today belongs to the Benedictine Nuns. Impressive, hidden between mountains and a lake surrounded by rhododendrons, the abbey is situated in a romantic place of great beauty. The entrance hall and three other rooms are open to the public. Restored by the Nuns in a major restoration project, it can be described as a 'cathedral in miniature' and is very faithful to the so-called, "Decorated Style Church". Return to your hotel to freshen-up.

This evening's performance will be held at St. Nicholas Collegiate Church or at the University in Galway presented by Embry Hills United Methodist Church Choir (subject to confirmation).

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Galway. (B,D)
(Possible Sunday Worship at local United Methodist Church.)

Day 4 September 24, Monday: Burren Region - Cliffs of Moher - Killarney

Irish breakfast at your hotel. This morning, you will be transferred to the Magnificent Cathedral of Galway. **Informal recital at Galway Cathedral, presented by Embry Hills United Methodist Church Choir.**

Then, we drive through the most spectacular Burren Region. 'Boirean' is the Irish for 'Rocky.' It got its name from its polished limestone landscape. It is a glaciokarstic plateau with porous carboniferous limestone and shale systems. It is hard to believe that it was once lightly wooded and covered in soil. At the end of the Stone Age, nearly 6,000 years ago, farmers arrived. The farmers left their animals grazing and this, along with natural weathering, stripped the soil of vegetation leaving this rocky landscape behind. The whole area, with its rich liana and fauna, is heaven for geologists and botanists. It also has over 2,500 historical sites to keep you busy. Stop at the Cliffs of Moher. The most majestic cliffs in Ireland rise from the Atlantic Ocean at 215 meters and extend for over seven kilometers. From this height, you can admire the Aran Islands and the Connemara Mountains, and listen to the many sea birds that colonize this place from springtime on.

Independent lunch en-route.

This afternoon, we enjoy a short ferry ride across the wide estuary of the River Shannon from Listowel and Castle Island to Tarbert.

Continue to Killarney for hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Killarney. (B,D)

Day 5 September 25, Tuesday: Cashel – Cahir Castle

Irish breakfast at your hotel.

This morning, travel to visit the Rock of Cashel, one of Ireland's great historic sites. Cashel was the seat of the Munster Kings from about AD 370 until 1101, when it was granted to the church. It has very early associations with St. Patrick. The magnificent group of ecclesiastical ruins, which crown the Rock, include St. Cormac's Chapel, an outstanding specimen of Hiberno-Romanesque art. Independent lunch.

Then, we continue to visit Cahir Castle. An imposing 13th-15th Century structure, Cahir Castle was skillfully designed by Conor O'Brien to be a state-of-the-art defensive castle. Appearing to grow from the actual rock on which it stands, the castle has been the scene of sieges and bombardments for centuries. The powerful Anglo-Norman family, the Butlers, came into the possession of the castle in 1375. The castle was captured three times in its history: it fell to Devereux, Earl of Essex, in 1599 after it had been battered for three days with artillery; it surrendered without a fight to Inchiquin in 1647; and again to Cromwell in 1650. Over the centuries, the Butlers considerably rebuilt and extended their stronghold. By 1599, however, the castle had reached its present appearance, with the only subsequent alterations taking place in the 1840s. In 1961, the last Lord Cahir died and the castle reverted to the State. The castle retains its impressive keep, tower and much of its original defensive structure. Today, the castle also features an excellent audio-visual show that informs visitors about its eventful history.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Clonmel. (B,D)

Day 6 September 26, Wednesday: Wicklow region - Glendalough - Dublin - Evening Evensong in Dublin

Irish breakfast at your hotel.

This morning, travel to Ireland's capital via County Wicklow, known as the Garden of Ireland. This is home to Powerscourt, Mount Usher and Russborough, to name a few of its many houses and gardens. This region features all the various types of scenery that makes Ireland so beautiful. The coastline is bordered by charming sea resorts such as Bray or Greystones. In the heart of its gentle and rounded hills are nestled Enniskerry and Avoca, both very picturesque villages. Discover its romantic and quiet beauty, the deserted mounts where nothing but heather grows, the small forests and the lush prairies illuminated by yellow gorse in spring.

Independent lunch.

Visit **Glendalough**. The English name Glendalough originated from the Irish "Gleann Dá Locha", which translates as "The valley of the two lakes". It was here that St. Kevin, son of the king of Leinster, founded a monastery in the 6th century. From a simple beginning, the site grew to become famous as a centre of learning throughout Europe. Standing for 600 years, it was destroyed in 1398. Much of what is to be seen today dates from the 10th to the 12th century. One of the most attractive features is the fine 34-meter high round tower. A cathedral, stone churches, and decorated crosses also survived albeit as ruins. Glendalough has an excellent visitor's centre and display area, which is located at the entrance to the Valley. It houses a very comprehensive exhibition on Glendalough detailing the history, archaeology, and wildlife of this area of Wicklow.

Continue to Dublin for hotel check-in.

Early evening, you will be transferred to Christ Church Cathedral for Evensong, presented by Embry Hills United Methodist Church Choir. (subject to confirmation).

Independent dinner.

Overnight at hotel in Dublin. (B)

Day 7 September 27, Thursday: AM/At leisure - Noon/Concert at St. Patrick's Cathedral in Dublin - PM/Highlights Tour of Dublin - Evening Farewell Dinner

Leisurely Irish breakfast at your hotel. Morning at leisure.

At around 11:00am you will be transferred to St. Patrick's Cathedral for a noon recital, Embry Hills United Methodist Church Choir (subject to confirmation). Independent lunch.

This afternoon, discover Dublin's 'Fair City.' This tour will allow you to take in all the sights, including the famous 'Doors of Dublin,' the elegant Georgian squares, and Phoenix Park. Highlights of the tour will be a visit to **Trinity College** to view the 8th century illustrated manuscript, *The Book of Kells*, followed by a visit to St. Patrick's Cathedral, Ireland's largest Cathedral made famous by former Dean Jonathan Swift (Dean of St. Patrick's 1713-1745), author of *Gulliver's Travels*. The cathedral, built in 1213, is the largest in Ireland. This Gothic cathedral, with a splendid interior, is adorned with funeral monuments, such as The Boyle Family Memorial and the grave of Dean Jonathan Swift. The Chancel has ornate stained-glass windows, some by Harry Clarke, which are magnificent features. We recommend a stroll down Grafton Street, where you can enjoy the best in street entertainment and a coffee in Bewley's Café. The shopping is also great in this area of the city! Optional on your own, perhaps you will visit the Guinness Storehouse to see how this famous brewery was established and how the popular black brew is created.

This evening, enjoy dinner and entertainment at The Merry Ploughboy Pub. This is a state-of-the-art music venue open seven nights a week, all year round. Their lively show features contemporary Irish dancing and well-known guest artists. Fine food is a very important element. At The Merry Ploughboy Pub, youthful vibrancy has successfully combined with traditional craftsmanship to provide an excellent evening entertainment. Overnight at hotel in Dublin.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (\$1,450.00) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. *Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the land only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport.*

Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: Due to bus space, one carry-on bag and one checked bag per person are permitted. Standard airline baggage policies usually allow checked baggage up to 62 total inches and range to 50 pounds and carry-on baggage up to 45 total inches and 26 pounds. LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Reservations are subject to deadlines with airlines and various vendors. Special delivery charges incurred will also be due in advance.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person.
